Compétences interculturelles, “Intercultural Skills”, is a collection intended to present theoretical, empirical and practical work realised by scientific researchers and social actors. The objective is to identify, model and develop the resources and intercultural skills of those populations and institutions that are confronted with a multiplicity of socio-cultural references and contacts between various cultures. Intercultural skills are of capital importance, in particular in the dual effort to integrate the people who have migrated, and who must, at the very least, position themselves both with regard to the host society and their original background, both of which are undergoing constant transformation. Social workers in the broad sense, teachers, others who are active in this field, as well as decision makers in charge of initial and integration policies for migrants and cultural minorities are concerned with this type of professional skills needed to carry out effective social and pedagogical actions for these groups. Even if the objective of this collection is primarily to publicise the work of the Institute for Research, Training and Action for Migrations (IRFAM) and its numerous international partners, this section is open to multi-disciplinary teams which might wish to contribute to deepening the existing knowledge and know-how in the context of intercultural development. The collection has been enhanced by the contributions of an International Scientific Committee whose role is to evaluate the work and the chapters of work suggested for publication, as well as to initiate new topics. The Committee takes part in the orientation of the publication policy, dissemination and promotion of the collection. The collection is founded and directed by Dr. Altay A. Manço.
